


But millions of children are deprived of these basic rights for several reasons including conflict, natural calamities, ethnicity, disability, and above all poverty.

Jayanti Organization was established with the prime intention of facilitating children to overcome these barriers and the prevailing inequity in society. The Right to Education (RTE) Act which came into force in 2010 made education free and compulsory for all children in the age group of 6-14 years. However, more than a decade later, the learning curve has not been steady for all children. The socio-economic conditions of parents and gaps in the learning infrastructure and environment in schools are hindrances which prevent many children from getting a proper education. The National Education Policy of 2020 has introduced some welcome and progressive changes that are positioned to make India's education system more inclusive and holistic. Jayanti organization education interventions are focused on helping children from difficult circumstances to have access to equal opportunities for school completion and equitable learning outcomes. Our programs are aligned to the National Education Policy and aim to support the efforts of government to enhance accessibility of quality education for all children.

# DOORSTEP HEALTHCARE FOR TRIBALS In Odisha, Balasore

From the demographic structure to its health facilities, Odisha, Balasore District is very different to work in, particularly the tribal communities. Before we started this project, most of the people were dependent on alternate medicine. Now they trust us and regularly come for OPDs", the lead doctor of the Jayanti on Wheels mobile healthcare project in Balasore district of Urban areas. More than 6,000 children and families living in some of the remotest areas of Balasore district, are receiving free doorstep healthcare services through the project. The Jayanti organization on Wheels mobile hospital is reaching to the doorsteps of tribal communities in 6 villages, Along with providing primary healthcare services, the doorstep healthcare program is also giving special attention on behavioral change among children from the communities through awareness on hand washing, sanitization and maintaining general hygiene for staying healthy. While the change in the communities is gradually starting to show, the Jayanti organization on Wheels team feels that they too are blessed to be working with the tribal children, women and elders.

#### **CHILDREN AND FAMILIES: LIFECYCLE**

APPROACH Beginning in the corridors of education, Jayanti organization adopted a lifecycle approach and extended its thematic areas of intervention by supporting family health, livelihood, and women empowerment. Children, their families and the community become the target group for Jayanti organization activities as child education cannot be done in isolation, without ensuring the welfare of the whole family. Following the lifecycle approach, Jayanti organization has directly impacted the children and families so far.

#### **HEALTHCARE**

Jayanti organization healthcare intervention is providing primary healthcare facilities at the doorsteps of the underserved communities in the identified rural areas and urban slums. The aim is to reach the vulnerable population who cannot afford basic healthcare facilities.

### **NUTRITION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM**

Launched in 2021, the Nutrition Enhancement Program aims to improve the nutritional status of pregnant and lactating women, and children in the age group 0-6 years across 11 villages in Bhograi block of Balasore District, Odisha, Nutrition plays a critical role in growth and development of women and children. Maternal nutrition impacts woman's health during pregnancy in turn influencing health of her new born. Studies have shown that the child's health in their first 600 days of life is critical and as it influence the outcomes during childhood and later in adulthood. Hence, it becomes imperative to ensure healthy pregnancy and healthy women and children. Nutrition Enhancement Program focuses to strengthen the physical infrastructure and initiatives of the government system, build in awareness and knowledge amongst the community. The program also involves engaging with various stakeholders through capacity building. Some of the key activities under the program include:

Refurbishment of Anganwadi centers to make the Anganwadis accessible, informative, and attractive for children and mothers Amplifying significant days such as Anemia Mukt Bharat Diwas, Breastfeeding Week, Poshan Maah

Capacity Building Sessions of Anganwadi Workers through organizing trainings for the workers through experts

Knowledge building of mothers, pregnant and lactating women on importance of health and nutrition aspects like diet diversity, IFA consumption, birth preparedness, breast-feeding, etc.

Retaining practices and learning in the community on nutrition through sharing recipes using locally sourced high nutritional value ingredients

Establishing community and individual kitchen gardens by using waste material to grow local vegetables to ensure diet diversity in routine

















### **WOMEN EMPOWERMENT**

Over the past decades, gender equality has been recognized as crucial not only to the health of nations but also to their social and economic development. The promotion of gender equality and women empowerment is a key aspect of UNDP's Sustainable Development Goals. A community, society, and country prosper when its women are empowered. Skilled women join India's workforce and contribute to economy; healthy women lay down the foundation for healthy families; aware mothers ensure that their children go to school; empowered women become change makers and support other women. Jayanti organization women empowerment program Swabhiman, initiated in 2005, reaches out to marginalized and sociallyexcluded women with interventions in nutrition, healthcare and livelihood. The program capacitates women through innovative community practices, empowering them to seek healthcare and bring sustainable changes in the community, while also supporting them to become aware, skilled and financially independent. Swabhiman by far has been able to affirm through community actions and advocacy that though women face numerous sociocultural challenges coming from their prescribed societal roles and ascribed status within the family, community, and society, contravening such challenges is very much possible through creation of opportunities and enabling environment. The mainstay of Swabhiman program's community outreach is through Change Agents, Peers Educators, Community Health Educators and Swabhiman Health Volunteers. These change agents are identified from the community and empowered through regular training sessions on relevant issues. They further educate and spread awareness among their peers in the community. Such interventions and innovations lead to a comprehensive approach that addresses social, economic, and health challenges, promoting sustainable development, and leaving a positive and lasting impact on individuals, communities, and society as a whole.

# **CLOTHES Distribution to Needy**

Clothing is a fundamental need of the human kind. Apart from covering one's body, clothing protects us from the sun, rain and cold. Further, it gives dignity to our 'self'. Jayanti organization through its interaction with the community realized that clothing did much more than just covering the human body. For example, a few students in Odisha, Balasore who joined college were on the verge of becoming dropouts because they didn't have respectable clothes to wear. When this came to notice, Jayanti organization intervened by simply giving each of them 3 pairs of clothes suitable for college from its clothes bank "Vastra" and this simple initiative led to the continuation of their studies. Further it was noticed that in Odisha lack of decent clothing, deter women from stepping out of their house for months together. This in turn has other adverse implications on their empowerment and psychology that can be prevented easily with a few clothes, we are also provided the blankets and other clothes also distribute the school, college, and poor and needy people also.



Clothing distribution is an important initiative that provides essential clothing to needy individuals and families. Jayanti Organization This humanitarian effort aims to promote dignity, self-respect and warmth among vulnerable populations. By collecting and distributing gently used clothing, shoes and accessories, clothing distribution programs make a tangible difference in the lives of many people. The benefits . clothing distribution are multifaceted. First, it addresses the basic need for clothing, which is often taken for granted. Many individuals and families struggle to afford basic clothing items, leaving them vulnerable to harsh weather conditions and social exclusion. Clothing distribution programs help bridge this gap, ensuring everyone has access to warm, clean clothes. Our organization has taken the initiative to provide clothes to every poor or needy person, clothes distribution fosters community engagement and social cohesion. Volunteers and donors come together to support a common cause, building connections and strengthening community bonds. Recipients, too, experience a sense of belonging and gratitude, knowing that others care about their well-being. Effective clothes distribution programs prioritize dignity and choice. Recipients should have the opportunity to select items that suit their needs and preferences, rather than receiving handouts. This acknowledges the autonomy and individuality of each person.















# **Environment Protection & cleanliness:**

Jayanti organization realized that given the high dependency of man on ecosystem services, and given the growing unpredictability of Mother Nature, making the underprivileged conscious about nature is important. To this end, it partners with the underprivileged and facilitates plantation drives, undertakes cleanliness drives like say 'no' to plastics etc.



















# **Disaster Management:**

Natural calamities reveal that in the struggle for survival, the elderly are usually the last in the line and lost in the crowd, and therefore suffer the most. Jayanti organization started its disaster intervention programs in the year 2018. The first of its kind among voluntary organizations, the Jayanti organization unit was trained and equipped to bring swift and effective counter measures in the face of disasters. Today, Jayanti organization disaster response model is equipped to rush in quickly to reach out not only to the elderly but also to the community at large, providing relief with food, Tarpaulin, clothing and shelter to establishing long-lasting rehabilitation programs. Which is why, Jayanti organization could immediately respond to disasters such as Odisha, West Bengal also.













### **AWARENESS PROGRAM**

The services provided under Jayanti organization will provide awareness programs, training and capacity building to create demand and also be partners in implementation of programs. This will act as a forum for addressing social issues of Education, Women & Child, Health & and Vulnerable groups. It will offer a platform to come together, explore potential and possibilities. It will also bridge information and knowledge gap regarding programs and facilities available for them.

# **LIVELIHOOD**

The skill training and livelihood program of Jayanti organization is closely aligned with the 'Skill India' initiative of the Government of India. Through specialized training courses, we aim to empower individuals with relevant and in-demand skills, enabling them to adapt to the changing job market and secure meaningful employment opportunities. The program placed significant emphasis on comprehensive training and skill development. Tailored counseling sessions, engagement programs and hands-on experience, provide the young trainees with the tools and guidance needed to unlock their potential, creating a nurturing environment where they can explore their capabilities and cultivate their talents.



#### HYGIENE KIT DISTRIBUTION

Modern-day disposal pads are toxic, non-biodegradable, that ultimately clog our landfills for decades while the Lack of affordable menstrual hygiene products adds to the financial woes of underprivileged women. To address twin problems of environmental degradation and period poverty, we educate women and adolescent girls regarding the importance of menstrual hygiene. We are providing the Dettol, soap, detergent powder ,disposable pads, on women's health, and the environment. We urge the use of eco-friendly sanitary products like menstrual cups and cloth pads. Women form groups and discuss their experiences during menstruation and encourage each other to adopt suggested eco-friendly sanitation products. This program is helping underprivileged slum women and girls to change the conservative attitudes around menstruation.




